Granada's Costa Tropical, home of Marina del Este, is one of the most famous areas in Spain, known for having a beautiful sea bed and pleasant climate all year round.

It is ideal for all kinds of nautical and sporting activities. It consists of 227 berths for lengths up to 30 metres.





Things To Do & Facilities

There is a wide range of nautical activities that clients may choose from depending on their interests. You will find options such as boat hire (with or without a skipper) and aquabikes. Highlights include water sports such as diving. The Parque Acuático Aquatropic is located near the harbour. This park is ideal for families, with pipes and slides that lead to saltwater swimming pools.



MUST-SEE

The historical centre of Almuñécar is one of the most beautiful parts of the town. The district is known for its cobbled streets and unique squares.

San Miguel castle has Phoenician origins dating back to the 7th century BC. There are breathtaking views of both the sea and surrounding countryside.

One of the highlights of the Costa Tropical is the Almijara Nature Reserve, located in the River Verde valley in the municipalities of Otívar and Lentejé. The river is set in extraordinary ravines, making it an ideal spot for canyoning fans. The Junta de los Ríos area is simply spectacular, with waterfalls and natural pools that are a family destination in the summer. Numerous trails provide access to the most interesting areas.

Cerro Gordo natural beauty spot is another extraordinary protected space known for its rich natural submarine life, in addition to the plant life and spectacular cliffs. It's home to astounding beaches, a sea bed and trails along the cliffs. Highlights include the beaches at Cantarriján, Calaiza and the Berengueles cove on the border of the natural beauty spot, as well as Torre de la Caleta and the trail to the Torre de Cerro Gordo. There are numerous diving sites. We suggest you consult the diving guide to determine the best diving sites and diving centres in La Herradura and Almuñécar. They all offer dives in this unique part of Spain, which is ideal for scuba diving. Kayak excursions, stand up paddle boarding and cycling are fabulous experiences for the whole family.

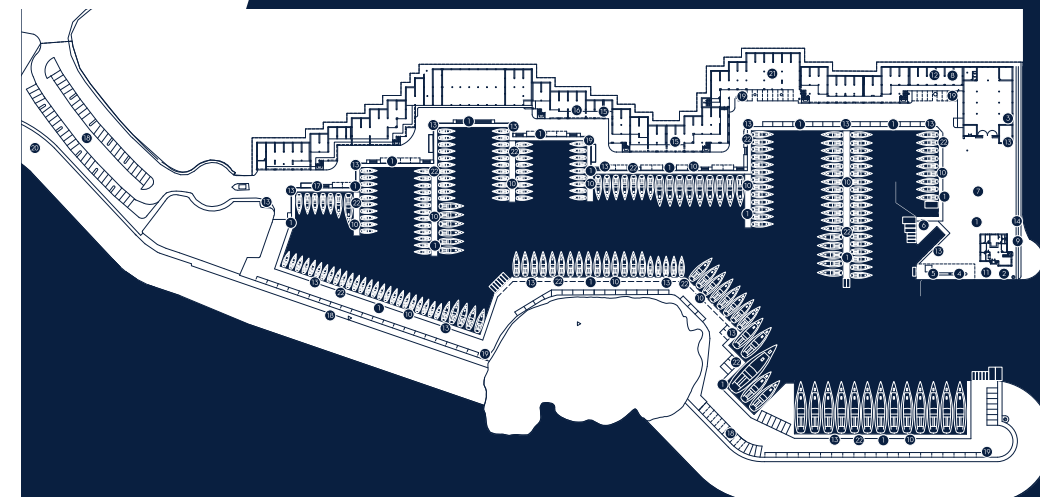

Duquesa

Puerto de la Duquesa is a beautiful marina in the municipality of Manilva and is the westernmost marina in the province of Málaga.

The harbour is currently the focal point for tourist activity in the area. It is surrounded by cosy hotels, suburban residential areas

and golf courses that invite you to enjoy your holidays with the sun, sea and sand.





Things To Do & Facilities

Puerto La Duquesa stands out for offering its inhabitants and visitors a vast selection of golf options. With splendid courses and an agreeable climate during most of the year, you can enjoy this beautiful sport with sea views, in touch with nature.

The cuisine at Marina La Duquesa is typical of the Costa del Sol. There is a wide range of restaurants and bars offering classic local fresh fish, particularly the famous sardine skewers at the beach bars in Sabinillas. Manilva also has a strong winemaking tradition. You can visit wineries and vineyards and taste the emblematic sweet wine made traditionally by the locals. Inland and in the surrounding area you can enjoy traditional country meals, with restaurants that offer exquisite meats. To round off the evening, you can try a tasty cocktail while watching the sun go down at one of the bars in our marina. The marina has shops and a small supermarket. The local shopping mall is just five minutes from the harbour.



MUST-SEE

Castillo La Duquesa

La Duquesa castle is located on La Duquesa beach, in the suburb known as El Castillo, in Manilva, in the province of Málaga.

Villa Matilde House

This house was owned by a brother of Blas Infantes, considered the father of Andalusian nationalism. It displays some of the archaeological remains from the Roman period found in Manilva.

Santa Ana Parish Church

Built in the late 18th century, on the site of another smaller church from the late 16th century. It is located at the heart of Manilva.

Canuto de la Utrera

The Canuto de la Utrera is a hiking route that you just can't miss. The site emerges from the depths of the ocean and is made up of a maze of karst landforms and inhabited by one of the most endangered species of Mediterranean.

Hedionda Roman Baths

If you'd like to relax surrounded by nature, don't miss Hedionda Roman Baths. These baths were part of an old Roman spa dating back to the 1st century AD that has been restored and equipped for free use by the public. Such is the significance of this architectonic space that it was declared a "Site of Cultural Interest".

If you're looking for adventure at the heart of nature, you can try rafting on the Guadiaro River.

At 79 km long, the Guadiaro River is one of the main rivers in the Mediterranean basin of Andalusia, and is the third longest after the rivers Guadalhorce and Almanzora, and one of the largest in terms of flow.

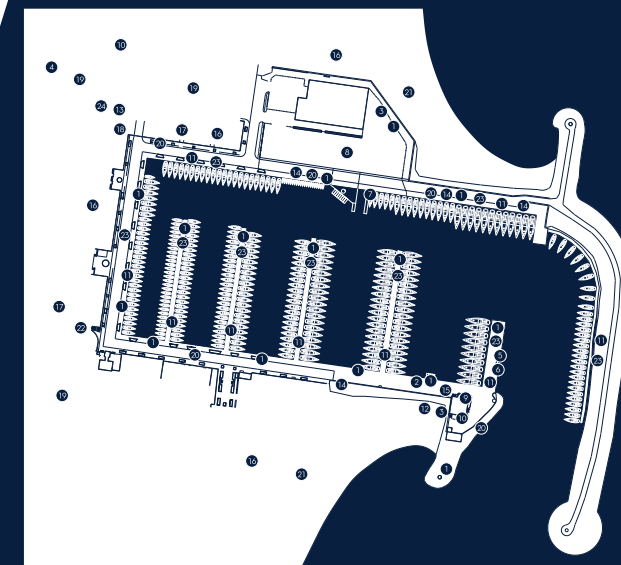

This marina is located near the Estepona town centre and consists of 447 berths for lengths up to 35 metres.



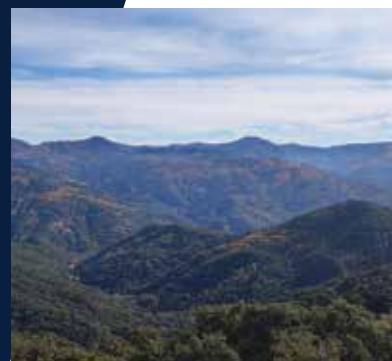


Things To Do & Facilities

The harbour is near supermarkets and shops. The marina hosts a market selling crafts, clothing and accessories every Sunday.

San Luis castle is the ruin of a 16th-century military fort.

A classic route among the region's cyclists and the Puerto de Peñas Blancas stage endpoint in the 2013 Vuelta Ciclista a España. The climb up Peñas Blancas provides some of the most exclusive views of the shoreline and the African coast.

The Valle del Genal is located in the province of Málaga. It is in the Serranía de Ronda region, in the south-east of the province, covering approximately 485 km. People visit the Valle de Genal for rural tourism, to walk along its paths and to discover hearty mountain cuisine that is bursting with flavour. It is located between the Serranía de Ronda and the Sierra de las Nieves.

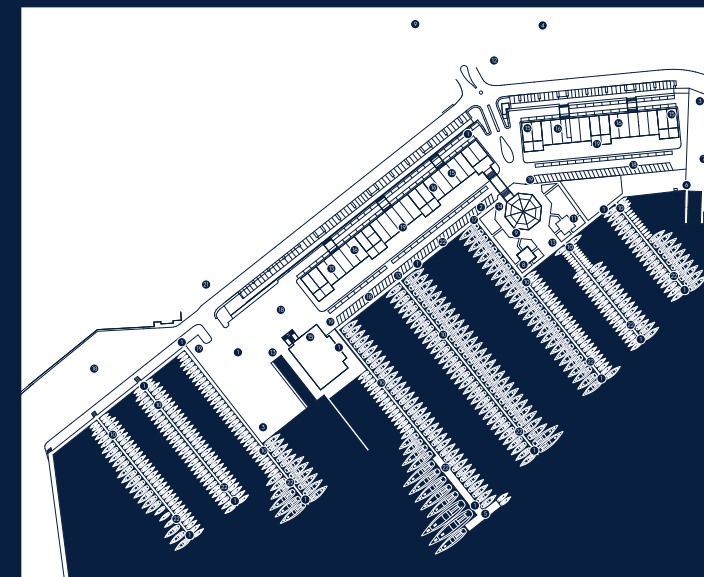
